

**APPLICATION UNDER THE PLACES OF REFRESHMENT (JERSEY) LAW 1967  
FOR A PERMIT TO OPEN ON SUNDAYS, GOOD FRIDAY AND CHRISTMAS DAY**

*Holders of a Liquor Licence issued under the Licensing (Jersey) Law 1974 do not require a permit under the 1967 Law to open on Sundays, Good Friday and Christmas Day.*

Premises registered as a Place of Refreshment under the 1967 law (e.g. restaurant, café, snack-bar, tea shop, canteen or any other place at which meals or refreshment are sold) may not open on any Sunday, or on Good Friday or Christmas Day unless a permit has been granted by the Connétable of the parish in which the premises are situated. A permit is valid from 1<sup>st</sup> May to 30<sup>th</sup> April.
