Non-exempt (public) under Freedom of Information (Jersey) Law 2011

- Minutes 1. The minutes of the meeting held on 13th November 2017, having been previously circulated, were taken as read and were confirmed.
- Draft Budget Statement 2018 (P.90/2017) and draft Finance (2018 Budget) (Jersey) Law 201-201- (P.98/2017) 2. The Supervisory Committee, with reference to its minute no. 2 of 13th November 2018 and to the Comité des Connétables minute no. 1 of 16th November 2018, noted the decision of the States that the current exemption from rates (parish and island-wide) for houses and other buildings, with any premises appertaining thereto, and land used predominantly for the purpose of parking vehicles, owned or occupied by a public authority, should be removed from 1st January 2018 (the exemption relating to a parochial authority was unchanged in Articles 17 and 18 of the Rates (Jersey) Law 2005).
- Association of Jersey Rates Assessors - AGM 3. The Supervisory Committee, with reference to its minute no. 5 of 18th September 2017, received a report from the Chairman following his attendance at the Annual General Meeting of the Association of Jersey Rates Assessors. The Committee was informed that the Chairmen of the parochial Assessment Committees did not meet to discuss the rating of property and agreed it should recommend that they should meet to ensure that there was a commonality of approach and that there was uniformity in rateable values throughout Jersey.
- Rates (Jersey) Law 2005 – rating of moveable horse shelters 4. The Supervisory Committee, with reference to its minute no. 2 of 10th April 2017, considered a letter regarding the assessment of field shelters and agreed it should write to the Association of Jersey Rates Assessors to ascertain how these were rated across the island.
