Pursuant to an Act of the Royal Court dated the 12th Day of February 2016 whereby it was ordered that an Election for Centenier be held in the Parish of Grouville, Paul Robinson having resigned his said office. An Assembly of Electors of the Parish of Grouville was duly convened and held at Grouville Parish Hall on Wednesday the 2nd March 2016.

In The Chair: Connétable J. E. Le Maistre presided over an Assembly of 18 persons.

Apologies: Reverend Mike Lang-Smith, Wally Labey and Peter Hollywood.

After the Act of Court and Convening Notice had been read, the Connétable invited nominations for the post of Centenier.

Stanley Payn declared that it was a pleasure to be able to propose the Nomination of Paul Godel as Centenier. Stanley read the nomination paper to the Assembly.

Stanley confirmed that Paul had joined as a Constables Officer in 1982, moving up to Vingtenier in 1985, then Centenier in 1991. After a brief break, he had returned as a Vingtenier in 2015. Stanley had spoken to Pauls wife Sue, and she was happy to support him moving back up as Centenier. Paul was a stayer, reliable and a stalwart.

In seconding the nomination, John Lamy confirmed that it was a pleasure to be able to second Paul Godel for Election as Centenier.

As there were no further nominations and the time required by law had passed, Connetable Le Maistre declared Paul elected as Centenier. The Connetable thought Paul had a fantastic record and he enjoyed working with him.

In closing the Meeting at 7.45pm, the Connetable warned Paul to expect formal notification from the Returning Officer Jurat Geoffrey John Grime to appear before the Royal Court on Friday the 1st April 2016 at 10am to be sworn in, subject to the satisfactory return of the normal Police Checks.
