

Parish of Grouville.
Electoral Assembly.

Pursuant to an Act of the Royal Court dated the 24th Day of July 2015, whereby it was ordered that an Election for Centenier be held in the Parish of Grouville, the Term of Office of Anne Elizabeth Viney being due to expire. An Assembly of Electors of the Parish of Grouville was duly convened and held at Grouville Parish Hall on Wednesday the 12th August 2015 at 7.45pm.

In the Chair: Connetable J.E. Le Maistre presided over an Assembly of 42 persons.

Apologies: Brigadier and Mrs Bruce Willing, Mrs Anita Rayson, Mr and Mrs M. Mash, Mrs Fiona Pastor, Mrs Pauline Bertram and Centenier Paul Godel.

After the Act of the Royal Court and the Convening Notice had been read out, the Connétable invited nominations for the said Office.

After reading the nomination paper, Stanley Payn stated that it was a pleasure to be able to propose Liz for re-election as Centenier. Liz had moved into the Parish 25 years ago and had offered her services as CO in 2006. She enjoyed this role so much that she was elected Vingtenier in 2007 and Centenier in 2009. Liz was well known, hardworking and not afraid to take any task on. Stanley felt that other Parishes would be envious of Grouville as the Parish was very fortunate to be re-electing Liz tonight.

As there were no further nominations, the time required by Law having passed, the Connetable declared Liz Viney re-elected and warned her to appear before the Royal Court on Friday the 11th September 2015 at 10am to be sworn in. The Connetable was pleased that Liz had put herself forward for another term of Office and thanked all four Centeniers for their hard work.
