

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish was held in the Parish Hall on Wednesday the 12th December 2018 at 7.30pm to conduct the following business:-

- 1) To receive and if deemed advisable approve the Minutes of the Parish Assembly held on the 26th September 2018.
- 2) To elect two members of the Rates Assessment Committee for a period of three years.
- 3) To Elect an Officier Du Connetable for the Vingtaine of De La Rocque.

In the Chair: Connetable John Le Maistre presided over an Assembly of 22 persons.

- 1) The Minutes of the Assembly held on the 26th September 2018 were agreed on a proposition by Robin Hamilton-Howes and seconded by Dave Cummins.

- 2) **To elect two members of the Rates Assessment Committee for a period of three years.**

Robin Alletson proposed the election of Mr Bruce Burnett, who unfortunately was unable to attend the Assembly as he was out of the Island. Bruce had lived in the Parish for 25 years and was known to all of the Assessors. Anthony Powell seconded the nomination.

As there were no further nominations, the Constable declared Anthony Powell re elected and Bruce Burnett elected and warned them to appear at the Royal Court on Friday the 21st December 2018 at 10.00am.
