ELECTORAL ASSEMBLY

Whereas by Act of the Royal Court dated the twenty-second day of April 2016, an Election was ordered by the said Court to be held in the Parish of St Clément to elect one person to fill the office of Centenier; the term of office of Mr Eduarte Nuno Caldeira being due to expire.
