



Parish of St Clément

PARISH ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Clément was held at the Parish Hall on **Tuesday 4 August 2015 at 7.00 pm to:-**

1. On the recommendation of the Roads Committee

a) to consider and if deemed appropriate to agree that the roads known as Le Squez Road and School Road be extinguished in accordance with the Extinguishment of Roads (Jersey) Law 1972 and ownership transferred to Andium Homes Limited to enable the reconfiguration of those roads;

b) to consider and if deemed appropriate to accept from Andium Homes Limited, at no cost, a parcel of land situated between the entrance to the supermarket car park and La Grande Route de la Côte;

c) to note that Andium Homes Limited will pay all legal costs reasonably incurred by the Parish in the transaction;

d) to authorise the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public to appear in the Royal Court to exchange the necessary contracts.

2. To consider, and if deem advisable, to permit Transport and Technical Services to construct a bus shelter, subject to public consultation and planning permission, on Parish land at La Charriere at no cost to the Parish. (Draft plans will be available at the meeting)

1. On the proposition of Mr Glen Hamel and seconded by Mr Mark Mathew the Assembly was asked to vote by raising their hands. Eleven votes were cast in favour of the proposition and thirteen against. The proposition was therefore defeated.

2. Following a presentation from Mr Craig Miller of Transport and Technical Services it was agreed to permit the construction of a bus shelter at La Charriere at no cost to the Parish. This was proposed by Mr Gerrard Baudains and seconded by Deputy Simon Bree.
