



Parish of St Clément

Parish Assembly

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Clément was held at the Parish Hall on **Tuesday 7 July 2015 at 7.00 pm to:-**

1. Receive, and if deemed advisable, adopt the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2015; the said accounts having been previously examined and unanimously approved by the Committee appointed for that purpose, and audited by the Parish Accountants, BBA Audit and Assurance Services Limited
2. Approve the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2016 to include a sum of money for the upkeep and maintenance of the by-roads and a sum of money for the purpose of making grants to various Charities and Organisations to be allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public
3. Approve a rate of an amount that will produce for the Parish income that is at least sufficient to satisfy the requirements as set out in the approved estimates
4. Name a Committee to examine the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2016
5. Appoint a firm of auditors to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2016

1. On the proposition of Mr Trevor Le Sueur and seconded by Mr David Bull, the Assembly unanimously adopted the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2015.
2. On the proposition of Mrs Anne Dupre and seconded by Mr Robert Le Sueur, the Assembly unanimously approved the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2016, a total sum of £790,815. This included the sum £81,500 for the upkeep and maintenance of the by-roads and the sum of £11,500 for the purpose of making grants to various Charities and Organisations to be allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public
3. On the proposition of Mr David Bull and seconded by Mr Christopher Le Cornu, the Assembly unanimously approved a rate of .88 pence per quarter.

4. On the proposition of Mr Gerard Baudains and seconded by Mr Alan Le Breton, the current members of the Committee to examine the Connétable's accounts were re-elected, namely, the two Procureurs du Bien Public, the two Deputies, the Rector, two Churchwardens, the Chef de Police and Mr Malcolm Machon.
5. BBA Audit and Assurance Services Limited were elected to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2016 having been proposed by Mr Anthony Perkins and seconded by Mr Trevor Le Sueur.

Before closing the meeting the Connétable expressed his special thanks to everyone associated with the Parish for their continued help and support.

Mr Robert Le Sueur recorded his gratitude to the Connétable and staff for a well-run Parish.
