



Parish of St Clément

PARISH ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Clément was held at the Parish Hall on **Tuesday 11 April 2017 at 7.00 pm to:**

1. Consider a request from the St Clément Battle of Flowers Association for the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public to increase the annual grant for the year 2017/18 to £4,000 subject to conditions agreed by the Association.
2. Agree that the Lease of Le Hocq Tower to The Jersey Heritage Trust be renewed from June 24, 2017 for a period of 25 years at a rent of £10 per annum with the Trust being responsible to the Parish's reasonable legal fees and to authorise the Connétable and at least one Procureur du Bien Public to appear in the Royal Court to exchange the necessary contracts.
3. Elect a Constable's Officer for the Grande Vingtaine.

1. Graham Gibson spoke on behalf of the St Clément Battle of Flowers Association who in return for an increase in funding have agreed to:
 - a) Use their best endeavours to ensure that there is a Miss St Clément Competition
 - b) Ensure that Miss St Clément has a starring role on the exhibit
 - c) Ensure that as far as possible individuals walking with or appearing on the float are St Clementais or have close connections with the Parish
 - d) Provide evidence of significant fundraising activities
 - e) Provide evidence of fixing and adhering to a positive budget
 - f) Provide evidence of a commitment to cost cutting wherever reasonable

On the proposition of Mr Anthony Perkins and seconded by Mrs Anne Dupre, the Assembly unanimously approved that the annual grant to the Association be increased to £4,000 for the year 2017/18. The Connétable advised that the funds would be paid after the Parish Rate had been agreed.

2. On the proposition of Deputy Susie Pinel and seconded by Mr Alan Le Breton, the Assembly unanimously agreed that the Lease of Le Hocq Tower to the Jersey Heritage Trust be renewed from June 24, 2017 for a period of 25 years at a rent of £10 per annum with the Trust being responsible for the Parish's reasonable legal fees and authorised the Connétable and a Procureur du Bien Public to appear in the Royal Court to exchange the necessary contracts.
3. **Miss Heidi May Baker** was duly elected as a Constable's Officer for the Grande Vingtaine having been proposed by Mrs Arsenia Paula Gouveia and seconded by Mr Antonio Martins.
