



Parish of St Clément

Parish Assembly

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Clément was held at the Parish Hall on **Tuesday 26 June 2018 at 7.00 pm to:-**

1. Receive, and if deemed advisable, adopt the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2018; the said accounts having been previously examined and approved by the Committee appointed for that purpose, and audited by the Parish Accountants, PKF BBA Audit and Assurance Limited and to agree to transfer from the General Reserve: -
 - a) £15,000 to the Replacement Vehicle Reserve
 - b) £15,000 to the Church, Rectory and Cemetery Maintenance Fund.
2. Approve the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2019 to include a sum of money for the upkeep and maintenance of the by-roads and a sum of money for the purpose of making grants to various Charities and Organisations to be allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public
3. Approve a rate of an amount that will produce for the Parish income that is at least sufficient to satisfy the requirements as set out in the approved estimates
4. Name a Committee to examine the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2019
5. Appoint a firm of auditors to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2019


1. On the proposition of Mrs Anne Dpure and seconded by Mr John Pinel, the Assembly unanimously adopted the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2018 and agreed the transfers to the Replacement Vehicle Fund and the Church, Rectory and Cemetery Maintenance Fund.
2. On the proposition of Mr Peter Windsor and seconded by Mr Gerard Baudains, the Assembly unanimously approved the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2019, a total sum of £844,837. This included the sum £86,800 for the upkeep and maintenance of the by-roads and the sum of £13,500 for the purpose of making grants to

various Charities and Organisations to be allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public

3. On the proposition of Mr Gerard Baudains and seconded by Mrs Thelma Heard, the Assembly unanimously approved a rate of .89 pence per quarter.
4. On the proposition of Mr Gerard Baudains and seconded by Mr Trevor le Sueur, the Assembly unanimously agreed that the current members of the Committee to examine the Connétable's accounts be re-elected, namely, the two Procureurs du Bien Public, the two Deputies, the Rector, two Churchwardens, the Chef de Police and Mrs Sandra Mathew.
5. On the proposition of Mr Brian Heard and seconded by Tony Perkins, the Assembly unanimously agreed that PKF BBA Audit and Assurance Limited be re-appointed to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2019.

Mrs Sue Pearmain thanked the Connétable for his support and before closing the meeting the Connétable expressed his special thanks to everyone associated with the Parish.

The Assembly was attended by 29 Parishioners.
