



Parish of St Clément

PARISH ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Clément was held at the Parish Hall on **Tuesday 29 November 2016 at 7.00 pm to:**

1. In conformity with Article 32 of the Rates (Jersey) Law, 2005, to elect two people as members of the Assessment Committee to serve a three-year period with effect from 1 January 2017.
2. Consider the following application for a Licence for the year 2017 in virtue of the Licensing (Jersey) Law, 1974:-

Name: Le Riche Group Limited
Business address: Costcutter
La Grande Route de la Côte
St Clément
Category: 6th (off-licence)

3. To consider, and if deemed advisable, agree, on the recommendation of the Roads Committee, the establishment of the boundary between the property known as "L'Industrie", Rue de Samarès and the Parish pavement at no cost to the Parish, and to authorise the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public to pass any necessary contracts.

1. On the proposition of Mr Bryan Harrison, and seconded by Mr Trevor Le Sueur, the Assembly unanimously re-elected **Mr Albert Owen Brown** as a member of the Assessment Committee. On the proposition of Mrs Anne Dupre, and seconded by Trevor Le Sueur, the Assembly also unanimously re-elected **Mrs Mary Barton** as a member of the Assessment Committee. Both were re-elected for a three-year period from 1 January 2017.
 2. On the proposition of Mrs Alison Correia, and seconded by Mrs Linda Symes, the Assembly unanimously voted in favour of the application by Le Riche Group Limited (Citriche Limited) for a 6th Category licence (off-licence) for the premises currently known as Costcutter, La Grande Route de la Côte, St Clément.

Mr Alan Le Breton addressed the Assembly.

3. On the proposition of Mr Trevor Le Sueur, and seconded by Mrs Anne Dupre, the Assembly unanimously voted in favour of the recommendation of the Roads Committee to establish the boundary between the property known as L'Industrie, Rue de Samarès, and the Parish pavement at no cost to the Parish and to authorise the Connétable and Procureurs du Bein Public to pass any necessary contracts.
