Minutes of Parish Assembly

- 1) To receive and if deemed advisable approve the Minutes of the Act of the Parish Assembly held on 21st August 2013; these are on display at the Parish Hall.

The Minutes of 21st August 2013 were proposed by Centenier Nicola Parker-Hood and seconded by Mr John Emmanuel. On a vote all were in favour, none against. The Connétable then signed the Minutes as approved.

- 2) To elect a member of the Roads Committee to complete the term of office of the late Mr Graeme Journeaux.

The Connétable asked for nominations and Mr Charles Le Cornu stood to address the Assembly.

He said that it gave him great pleasure to propose Mr Eton Winston Le Brun to complete the term of office of the late Mr Graeme Journeaux. Mr Le Cornu told the Assembly that Mr Le Brun, who is known as Winston, had lived in the Parish for many years. He knew the Parish well, possibly knowing “every road, every hedge and every tree” and importantly, he had attended many Branchages. Mr Le Cornu had no hesitation in proposing him as a member of the Roads Committee.

Procureur Mr Michael Ethelston seconded the proposal, telling the Assembly that he had known Mr Le Brun for many years, knew him to be an able man and if elected, he looked forward to working with him.

There being no further nominations, Connétable Mezbourian declared that Mr Eton Winston Le Brun had been duly elected as a member of the Roads Committee to complete the term of office of the late Mr Graeme Journeaux.

The Connétable warned Mr Le Brun to appear in the Royal Court at 10 a.m. on Friday 27th September 2013 to be sworn to office.

The Connetable then offered her congratulations to Mr Le Brun, telling the Assembly that his loyalty to, and knowledge of, the Parish would be invaluable as a member of the Roads Committee and she too looked forward to working with him.

The Connétable invited Mr Le Brun to address the Assembly and he thanked his proposer and seconder, and those others present for their support. He added that he was looking forward to working with the Roads Committee and to doing his best for it.

Before closing the meeting, the Connetable expressed her sadness and regret at the passing of Mr Graeme Journeaux. She reminded those present that he had been a valued and respected member of the Roads Committee and that he would be missed by them all.
