STAY AT HOME

All Islanders who are not doing essential work are ordered to 'stay at home' at all times until the end of April, except for a limited number of reasons.

1. Infrequent shopping for food, medicine, and other basic necessities
2. exercise, provided you maintain social distancing
3. medical needs, including providing care

Support is Available

You may need support for many reasons, such as shopping for essentials, personal care, short term financial difficulties or mental wellbeing. Support is available by calling Parish office on 482700 or the Coronavirus support line on 445566. Your call will be dealt with in complete confidence.

Volunteer Support

Across the island over 2,000 people and 170 businesses have registered to provide support. Within the Parish we will arrange for the volunteers to carry ID in the form of a letter signed by the Connétable. All volunteers know to maintain social distancing, please help to keep them and yourself safe by ensuring you keep 2m apart from any volunteer who comes to your door.
