An Assembly of Principals and Electors of the Parish of St. Peter will be held in the Parish Hall on Wednesday 08 November 2017 , at 7.30pm to:-

1. Receive, and if deemed advisable, approve the Act of the Parish Assembly held on Wednesday 13 September 2017.
2. In accordance with Article 32 of the Parish Rate (Jersey) Law 2005, to elect a member of the Assessment Committee, for a period of three years the term of office Roger Charles Raymond Noel, due to expire in November 2017.
3. Elect a Constables Officer for Vingtaine de St Nicolas, for a period of three years.
4. Elect a person to serve as Chairman of the Youth & Community Centre Management Committee for a period of three years, the term of office of Mark Capern due to expire in November 2017.
5. To elect two persons to serve as members of the Youth & Community Centre Management Committee for a period of three years, the terms of office of Marcus Butel and Jackie Knight due to expire November 2017.

- 1 On the proposition of **Mark Capern**, seconded by **Terence Avery**, the minutes of the Parish Assembly held on Wednesday 13 September 2017, which had been previously handed out, were approved.
- 2 A nomination for **Roger Charles Raymond Noel**, to be a member of the Assessment Committee was proposed by **Terence Avery**, seconded by **Eric Le Ruez**, for a period of three years. This will be Roger's third term of office as a Rates Assessor for the parish. The Constable thanked Roger for all his hard work in the past, the assessment committee make a good team and are all appreciated .Mr Avery was disappointed to see so few turn out for the assembly as all Rates Assessor have an onerous job to help the parish rouse finances. He is happy to support Roger for the next term of office.

As there were no further nominations, the Constable congratulated Roger and advised that a swearing in date for January 2018 will be advised.

- 3 Mr **Adrian Nowak** was nominated for the position of Constables Officer for Vingtaine de St Nicolas and proposed by **Richard Vibert**, seconded by **Rowland Huelin**.

The Constable thanked Mr Nowak for coming forward as a member of the Honorary police for St Peter, Adrian can speak Russian, Dutch, German, Polish and English which will be very useful, we have a wide range of nationalities in the honorary police in St Peter and we look forward to working with him. Mr Nowak was advised to attend the royal court on Friday 24 November at 10.00am unfortunately he is out of the Island on business before this date.

- 4 On the proposal of **Kerry Sharman, Mark Capern** was re-nominated for the role of Chairman of St Peters Youth & Community Centre, seconded by **Terence Avery**.

Mr Sharman said he could not think of any-one better than Mark for the position with all his experience and gives him great pleasure to nominate him. Mr Avery also stated that Mark is a capable, young bright man that is irreplaceable in his role and is very happy to second the nomination.

As there were no further nominations, the Constable thanked Mark for all his previous hard work, it has been noticed that the centre has improved financially with the new committee. Works are currently going on to improve the centre and looks forward to working with Mark and his team in the future.

- 5 Both **Marcus Butel and Jackie Knight** were proposed by **Mark Capern**, seconded by **Kerry Sharman** to re-stand as members of St Peters Youth & Community Centre. They were unable to attend the assembly as were attending a training course at Highlands but both are looking forward to continuing with assistance to the centre.

As there were no further nominations, the Constable asked Mark Capern to pass on his thanks and congratulations to both Marcus and Jackie for all their help in the past and for assisting us again in the future.

As there was no further business the Constable thanked everyone (9 people) for attending.
