

ELECTORAL ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Electors of the Parish of Trinity was held at the Parish Hall on Thursday 2nd November 2017 at 7.30 pm for the following business :-

1. Pursuant to an Act of the Royal Court dated 13th October 2017 whereby under Article 19 of the Public Elections (Jersey) Law 2002 it is ordered that an election for the office of Centenier be held.

To elect one Centenier, the term of office of Norman Edward Le Maistre due to expire.

The Connétable welcomed the Assembly to the meeting. Apologies were received from Centeniers Mrs S E Jones & C D Rook, P R Williams, D J Hinault, Vingt C A Fossey and CO J Howell.

The Minutes of the previous Electoral Assembly held on 9th February 2017 were read and adopted on the proposition of Mr J H Moulin and seconded by Deputy A Pryke.

1. Before asking for nominations for the position of Centenier, the Connétable thanked Centenier Le Maistre for his tireless work carried out to date on behalf of the Parish during his 21 years of service with the Parish and presented him with a silver baton de justice and an illuminated address.
