To elect one Connétable, the term of office of Philip Bond Le Sueur due to expire.

The Minutes of the previous Electoral Assembly held on 2nd November 2017 were read and adopted on the proposition of Mr J Le S Gallichan and seconded by Mr J H Moulin.

Being a candidate for the election, the Connétable then handed over the chairmanship to the Senior Procureur, Mr P R Williams, to conduct the meeting.
