

PARISH ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of Trinity was duly convened and held in the Parish Hall on Thursday 7th December 2016 at 7.30 pm to:-

Consider the following applications for recommendation to the Assembly of Governor, Bailiff and Jurats for the year 2016:

Name: Dodo Restaurant Ltd
Category: Fourth
Business Address: Durrell Wildlife Conservation Trust, La Profonde Rue, Trinity

Name: Rustic Rentals Ltd
Category: First
Business Address: Unit 1040, 24/7 Store, Rue de la Piece Mauger, Trinity

The Connétable welcomed everyone to the Assembly. Apologies were received from Reverend G J Houghton, Mr J Le S Gallichan and Mr J H Moulin.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted on the proposition of Mr C S Jones and seconded by Mr C Bray.

The following applications were then received by the meeting –

The Dodo Restaurant Ltd was represented by Mrs Brenda Piriozzolo who informed the Assembly that DWCT was applying for a 4th Category Licence to cover the whole park which would be transferred to the Dodo Restaurant Ltd when a new Manager would be appointed. On the proposition of Mr C S Jones and seconded by Mr C Bray, it was recommended that the application for a 4th Category Licence by Dodo Restaurant Ltd be unanimously recommended to the Licensing Bench.

Rustic Rentals Ltd was represented by Christopher Nixon who informed the Assembly that he was once again planning to apply for a 1st Category Licence following conversations with the States Treasury Department. He had put together a plan which was circulated to all present although not everyone was convinced he would be applying for the correct category licence. The Connétable informed the Assembly that he had been advised by Treasury as follows –

“No matter the outcome of the Parish Assembly, the Licensing Assembly may grant a 6th category in the alternative under Article 6(9) ‘Grant of Licences by Licensing Assembly’. The Licensing Assembly in deciding whether or not any application should be granted, may grant a licence of a category different from that for which application is made.” On the proposition of Mr N Vautier and seconded by Mrs D Lisher, it was recommended that the application for a 1st Category Licence by Rustic Rentals Ltd be recommended to the Licensing Bench with 3 in favour and 10 abstaining.

This being the final Assembly for the year, the Connétable conveyed best wishes and good health for Christmas and the New Year which were reciprocated by the Assembly and then declared the meeting closed.
