

## PARISH ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of Trinity was duly convened and held in the Parish Hall on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2018 at 7.30 pm for the following business:

1. To elect one Vingtenier for the Vingtaine of Ville a l'Eveque, the current holder's term of office due to expire.
2. To elect two Constable's Officers, one for the Vingtaine of Rozel and one for the Vingtaine of Rondin, the current holders' terms of office due to expire.
3. After the Assembly, our Parish Deputy, Hugh Raymond who is Assistant Minister at the Department of Infrastructure, will provide Parishioners with a short presentation on the Vienna Convention on Road Traffic 1968 and its effects on Jersey's legislation and there will be the opportunity to ask questions.

The Connétable welcomed the Assembly to the meeting. Apologies were received from Mr A G Blair, Mr J H Moulin and Mrs A Pryke.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted on the proposition of Vingtenier C E Simpson and seconded by Mrs A Otterwell.

1. Before asking for nominations, the Connétable thanked Alan Blair for his service to the Parish having carried out 12 years as a Constable's Officer and 3 years as Vingtenier for the Vingtaine of Ville a l'Eveque. On the proposal of Mr P R Williams and seconded by Mr C S Jones, Alan George Blair was re-elected as Vingtenier for the Vingtaine of Ville a l'Eveque and would be warned to attend the Royal Court on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2018 to take his oath of office.
2. The Connétable then went on to ask for nominations for a Constable's Officer for the Vingtaine of Rozel following the resignation of John Philip Vautier who had resigned from the post due to work commitments. No nominations were received for the position and the vacancy would be carried over.

The Connétable then went on to thank John Barrie Howell for his service to the Parish during the past 3 years in his first term as Constable's Officer for the Vingtaine of Rondin. On the proposal of Mr C H Raymond and seconded by Mrs A P Le Sueur, John Barrie Howell was re-elected as Constable's Officer for the Vingtaine of Rondin and was warned to attend the Royal Court on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> October 2018 to take his oath of office.

There being no further business, the Connétable declared the meeting closed and invited the Assembly to stay on for the informal discussion by Deputy Hugh Raymond and Mr Toni Miziolek.
