

Parish Assembly

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of Trinity was duly convened and held in the Parish Hall on Thursday 6th December 2018 at 7.30 pm to:-

1. To elect one Constable's Officer for the Vingtaine of Ville a l'Eveque, the current holders' term of office due to expire.
2. In accordance with Article 32 of the Rates (Jersey) Law 2005 to elect two members of the Assessment Committee to serve for three years from 1st January 2019, the terms of office of Mr M L Picot and Mr P Richardson being due to expire on 31st December 2018.
3. Consider the following application for recommendation to the Assembly of Governor, Bailiff and Jurats for the year 2019:

4. To authorise the Connétable and Procureurs to attend the Royal Court to pass a contract formalising the gift of an irregular shaped strip of land forming the south-western part of the field known as Le Grand Clos de Breton and bearing the number T237. This gift has enabled the construction of the pedestrian path linking the Parish Hall with the First Time Buyer Development at Le Grand Clos.

The Connétable welcomed the Assembly to the meeting. Apologies were received from Centeniers S Gallichan, C Rook & A Otterwell, Rev G J Houghton, Messrs P R Williams, A Mullins and P J Richardson.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted on the proposition of Mr D J Hinault and seconded by Mr C S Jones.

1. Before asking for nominations, the Connétable thanked Ashley Mullins for the work he had carried out during his first term of office as Constable's Officer for the Vingtaine of Ville a l'Eveque. On the proposal of Mr J Le S Gallichan and seconded by Mrs A P Le Sueur, Ashley Mullins was re-elected as Constable's Officer for the Vingtaine of Ville a l'Eveque and he would be warned to attend the Royal Court on a suitable date, to be arranged on his return to the Island.

2. Before asking for nominations, the Connétable gave special thanks to Michael Picot for serving the Parish for 3 terms as a Rates Assessor and for all the extra work he had carried out in connection with the changes to rates paid by the States of Jersey which had recently come into effect. He then went on to thank Peter Richardson for his first term in office as a Rates Assessor and the way in which he had carried out his duties.

On the proposition of Mr J H Moulin and seconded by Mr C S Jones, Peter John Richardson was re-elected for a second term and on the proposition of Mrs R J Parker and seconded by Mr M L Picot, Anne Philippa Hassell was elected for her first three year term. Both Assessors were warned to attend the Royal Court on Friday 14th December 2018 at 10.00 am to take their oaths of office.

Michael Picot responded by thanking the teams with whom he had worked during the past 9 years. Peter Davis thanked Michael Picot for his assistance and welcomed Anne Hassell to the team.

3. TPG Ltd was represented by Rupert Huelin who informed the Assembly that he had no intention of making changes to the way the shop was presently run but would be reviewing the

situation with regards to lowering prices through trading as 'Your Store'. He would be upgrading the current computer system so that sales of alcohol to underage customers would not occur. On the proposition of Mr J H Moulin and seconded by Mr P J Davis with all in favour, it was recommended that the application for a 6th Category Licence by TPG Ltd be unanimously recommended to the Licensing Bench. Mr Huelin was reminded that the Licensing Assembly would be held in the Royal Court at 10.00 am on Thursday 20th December 2018.

4. The Connétable explained to the Assembly that Mrs Collette Bisson had donated a strip of land to the Parish in order that a path could be constructed linking the Parish Hall with Le Grand Clos, the cost of which would be funded by the Overland Trust.

On the proposition of Mrs R Parker and seconded by Mr I Dulake, with all in favour, the Connétable and Mr J H Moulin, Procureur, were authorised to attend the Royal Court in order to pass the said contract.

Before closing the meeting, the Connétable asked the Assembly to remember Geoff and Fran Houghton in their prayers during this very difficult time they were going through. He went on to thank the office staff, the Procurers, the Municipality and the Honorary Police for their assistance throughout the year and wished everyone a happy and healthy Christmas and New Year.

In reply, Mr P J Davis reciprocated greetings to the Connétable and his family for 2019.

There being no further business, the Connétable declared the meeting closed at 7.50 pm.
