

PARISH ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of Trinity was held at the Parish Hall on Thursday 9th February 2017 at 7.30 pm for the following business :-

1. To elect one Constable's Officer for the Vingtaine of Rozel, the term of office of the current holder due to expire.
2. To consider the sale of an easement through Rue de la Falaise for Antler Properties Ltd to lay private drainage and water connection pipes in connection with the redevelopment of Bouley Bay Farm and if agreed, to authorise the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public to pass the appropriate contract on behalf of the Parish.
3. To consider the following application for recommendation to the Assembly of Governor, Bailiff and Jurats for the year 2017:

The Connétable welcomed everyone to the Assembly. Apologies were received from Centenier C D Rook, Mrs M Dunford and Dr & Mrs J Howell.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted on the proposition of Mr C Bray and seconded by Mr C S Jones.

1. Before asking for nominations, the Connétable thanked Mr Bray for his services to the Parish during his previous two terms of office. On the proposition of Mr A Dunford and seconded by Mr P W Corson, Christopher Bray was re-elected as Constable's Officer for the Vingtaine of Rozel and was warned to attend the Royal Court on Friday 17th February 2017 at 10.00 am to take his oath of office. Mr Bray thanked both his proposer and seconder and was looking forward to carrying out his new term of office.
2. With regards to the sale of an easement through Rue de la Falaise, Jamie Le Sueur, MD for Antler Properties Ltd, informed the Assembly that the company was in the process of refurbishing Bouley Bay Farm and was in the process of connecting the whole complex to the main drains and water supply, although if problems were encountered they may have to build a new pumping station. On behalf of the Roads Committee, Reverend G J Houghton thought that this was a reasonable proposition but would want the developer to reinstate the whole width of the road for its entire length and also cover all legal costs incurred. On the proposition of Reverend G J Houghton and seconded by Mr D J Hinault, the Connétable and Procureurs were duly authorised to pass the necessary contract before the Royal Court.
3. Rozel Bay Tearooms was represented by Mrs Maria Smith who informed the Assembly that it had been an oversight on her part that the renewal of the Licence for 2017 had been overlooked and she was hoping that the Assembly would support her late application. On the proposition of Mr J Le S Gallichan and seconded by Mr C S Jones with all in favour, it was recommended that the application for a 3rd Category Licence by Rozel Bay Tearooms be unanimously recommended to the Licensing Bench.

There being no further business, the Connétable declared the meeting closed.
