



This float is titled "Poultry in Motion" and is designed to be a song and dance float that's fun and crowd pleasing, with lots of movement. There will be approx 12 people in fixed positions on the float and others dancing on and off the float and will particularly suit the younger ladies of Trinity.

Costumes: The costumes will be stylised chicken outfits, that will be light weight comfortable and could be quite sexy!

Animation: Both the chickens and fox's head will move from side to side and the chicks will be popping up and down in their shells.

Music: The stargazers "There ain't nobody here but us chickens" is a lively dance track that will get everybody moving.

Costs: This design would be relatively easy to build and flower and would cost about the same as 2015's exhibit, but would be more interesting to look at. The fox would be done in Pampas grass, the chicks in Harestails, the less visible areas inside the hen house in dried leaves and the rest in fresh flowers.

Summary: This design ticks all the boxes. It is buildable and affordable and will be fun for both participants and spectators. The costumes are fairly simple and it will look good as a static display but will shine when peopled. And if done well it could win the Carnival Atmosphere, Most Humorous, Animation, and/or Best set Piece awards.
